Fishing Report

Newlyn

We had a pretty cold and windy club day at Newlyn on the 27th July. There were a few of us that had grabs and didn't connect and some good fish sighted but Roger landed the only fish of the day on his fourth cast. Roger's fish was full of gudgeon and smelt but they weren't smashing them consistently in the shallows for us. A couple of fish were spotted chasing smelt but they were pretty much "oncers". The water level has come right up in the last month and the old road is now too deep to wade along and the weed beds no longer visible.

Barkers Creek Res

Barkers is down to drought levels with the infrastructure works underway. Hopefully we'll see water levels start to rise again in the coming months

Hepburn Lagoon

John Guljas from Calder Fly Fishing Association reported that finding his usual smelting techniques unsuccessful, he began deep nymphing and hooked into a very big trout. He only managed to get it to the surface once (so at least he go to see it) before he was broken off. John estimated that it was over 10 lbs but we'll never know...

Lauriston Res

Damian, Tony and I fished the NW end of Lauriston on the 11th July for a few hours in the morning before Coliban Water staff kicked us out. We stayed well away from the 'dangerous' pine tree area but it made no difference; that end of the lake is off limits until the pines are removed. Estimated time for that: 1-5 years!!!

I fished the S end on the 13th July and caught a redfin and again on the 19th July and caught another Chinook whilst deep nymphing. This one was about 35 cm so they seem to be putting on weight and have dispersed throughout the lake. Let's hope they continue to fatten up quickly!

Upper Coliban Res

Tom and I fished the bays along the SE end on the 6th July and whilst I picked up a nice little rainbow of just under a pound early (and dropped another!!), things were pretty quiet for the rest of the day. They seemed to be pretty close in to the bank and took a kiwi damsel aggressively but moved out into deeper waters as the sun got higher.

Malmsbury

Malmsbury remains the colour of milky coffee and has in recent times had the greatest fluctuation in water levels out of all of the Coliban Lakes. Whilst it is a pity to see the conditions here decline, it is having the effect of keeping the levels at the Upper Coliban Res more stable, and that can only be a good thing.

Wendouree

I read a great Wendouree report from during the last week on the FlyStream Blog. Check it out online! In summary two anglers fishing from a boat had a great day fishing mostly the N side, with lots of action from smelters. It was possible to sight-fish to actively feeding trout and they landed plenty and dropped just as many again, most about 40 cm and 1½ pounds, and the biggest fish of the day pushing 4 lbs. The best flies were Magoos with copper or orange beads, and the trusty BMS. The trout ate the flies fished at all speeds but predominantly in the top 2 feet of the water column.

Loddon River

Damian fished the Loddon River on the 14th July and netted a beautiful 70cm Cod! He was using a Whistler Deceiver, slowly retrieved with a pause and the cod took it on the drop about a meter from the bank. After a few photos the cod was returned to the water.

Casting Encounters.

Once again I have arranged for my good friend Rob Roles to attend our Saturday casting clinics, Rob will be in attendance on Saturday 23rd August 1.30 pm. Rob will demonstrate and teach his flick cast [Bow and Arrow cast] if you have missed Rob in the past now is your opportunity to see a master of this technique in action.

On Saturday the 30th September “The Single and Double haul” will be the next technique on the agenda at the casting clinic. If you have not mastered these techniques, this is an opportunity to learn these valuable means to improve your casting. Cast with power, greater accuracy, in windy conditions and have greater control of all your casting. The ruination of great casting is slack line generated throughout the cast, correct “Hauling” will eliminate most of this problem.
