

## Fishing Report

Fly fishers are amazingly good at finding reasons why they cannot catch a fish. On a recent trip to the Tasmanian Highlands I heard many reasons why I couldn't find let alone catch a trout. Easter/Autumn and the more settled weather often leads to some good fishing in the Highlands. Sunshine and some wind inspires gum beetles to take to the wing often landing on the water and inducing the trout to rise. but when the weather god doesn't shine it seems the best time to be out on the lake is at first light on calm mornings. At this early hour midges hatch on frosty mornings and the trout come up and feed on the midge. My only excuse is that my bed is very warm and comfortable on frosty mornings. But even through the day we struggled to find a fish. However, we do have great memories of a trip a few Easters ago when the beetles (both gum and jassids) were on the water in good numbers. In overcast occasionally sunny weather we caught 1-3 kilogram fish on small dry flies drifting in a boat. But not this year. I haven't space to list the numerous excuses but will finish with the ever reliable excuse that we don't go fishing to catch fish. I'm sorry but I have to admit that while trout do live in beautiful places and I enjoy those places I do like to catch a trout on a fishing trip!! As Dr Robert Sloane says in "Watershed". "Fly fishing is as much about the insects, the weather, the water, the beauty, the wilds as it is about catching fish.-it is not a game of patience. It is a mental challenge and active pursuit which satisfies some inane need to hunt." I think he sums it up very nicely. I see that the next round of the Victorian championships is being moved to Toolondo Reservoir from Lake Fyans. Apparently Fyans is fishing very poorly whilst Toolondo is going well. I don't have any reports closer to home.
